

 - (e) IOC EB recommendations and March 1, 2022 World Sailing statement concerning the situation in Ukraine shall apply.



2 SCHEDULE OF RACES AND BRIEFINGS

- 2.1 PRACTICE RACING
- 2.2 Practice fleet racing is scheduled on May 8.
- 2.3 Skippers shall attend the first briefing, which will be at 11h00 on May 8 in the hospitality
- 2.4 The first meeting with the umpires will be at the same time.
- 2.5 The intended time of the first warning signal for the practice race on May 8 is 13h00.
- 2.6 Skippers shall be available for media requests, 30 minutes after the end of the last race each day.
